I find that I am angry, scared, and saddened, And this is as a woman over 50 who is not impacted directly, I can only imagine the extent of the emotions of others directly impacted by this decision.

This decision also came with the concurrent opinion that now threatens same sex marriage and a host of other rights we have founght for and even have taken for granted. This is a time for anger, sadness, and lament.

Lament is feeling grief and pain within us so deeply that it is embodied. It is a passionate response to grief and pain. The passionate response may be one of anger. Though our culture often questions anger it is only through anger that things get done. Anger is neither good nor bad - it is what we do with our anger that matters. Will we be destructive or constructive?

Constructive anger is the passion of change. Passion for change is love made real. Together we lament, grieve, become angry, and love. As people who are called to beloved community, love takes passion as we seek to "love the hell out of the world."

In the coming days and weeks hold tight to those most impacted, support them in where they are, shock, anger, lament, or whatever makes sense for them. While we do this, let us also envision how we can and do live out our mission of bringing love and justice into action.
